Title I Committee Meetings - Corley's process of recruitment for the Title 1 Committee meeting is as follows; a flyer will go home two weeks before each meeting inviting all parents to attend and parents who had attended the previous meeting will be invited back. The Parent Coordinator will send a formal invitation with a reminder call about the meeting. Three to five days before the meeting the agenda and copies of all items to be discussed will be sent home for parents to review. The committee members will also include school administrators, the Parent Instructional Support Coordinator, community members, and teachers. This committee will meeting at least three times a year (more if needed). The committee will revise the Title 1 School-wide Plan, which includes: Title 1 policy, action plan, and school compact. The school-wide Title 1 budget and Parent Involvement budget will also be revise during these meetings.
